Ch. 21) David commanded to count the number of Israelites, from Beersheba to Dan.

Ch. 23) "The Levites, thirty years old and upward, were numbered, and the total was 38,000 men. "And you, Solomon my son, know the God of your father and serve him with a (\_\_\_\_\_ ) and with a (\_\_\_\_\_ ), for the LORD (\_\_\_\_\_ ) all hearts and understands (\_\_\_\_\_ ). If you seek him, he will be found by you, but if you forsake him, he will cast you off forever."

Ch. 29) King David was unable to build the temple during his lifetime. However, David and the Israelites (\_\_\_\_\_ ) offered to build the house of the LORD. (Verses 6, 9, 14, 17)
