

MON May 23

Psalms express joy, sorrow, thanks and praise to God, confession of sins and repentance. In addition, it is used as a textbook of praise and faith during worship and festivals in Israel.

Ch. 1) "Blessed is the man who does not (.....) or (.....) or (.....) But his delight is (.....), and (.....)."

Ch. 2) This is a "royal poem" containing the Davidic Covenant. How does God react when "The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the Lord and against his Anointed"?

Ch. 3) This poem was written by David when he fled from his rebel son Absalom. We often think that God does not help us when we are in trouble. But what should we faithfully confess in times of difficulties? (Hint: verses 3-4)

Ch. 4) "In peace I will both lie down and sleep; for you alone, O (.....), make me dwell in safety."

Ch. 5) Write 3 or more types of evil people that God dislikes.

Ch. 6) "I am weary with my moaning; every night I flood my bed with (.....); I drench my couch with my weeping."

"The Lord has heard my (.....); the Lord accepts my (.....)."

Remember these words in a situation where you can do nothing but cry before God.

Ch. 7) This poem was written by David while he was on the run from Saul. Who does David confess is 'my shield'?

Ch. 8) Chapter 8 is a psalm of David that praises the creation of the heavens and the earth in Genesis. Write down the first and last sentence that repeats.

Ch. 9) This poem is a tribute to the conquest of the Ammonites.

"(.....) have sunk in the pit that they made; in the net that they hid, their own foot has been caught."

Ch. 10) This poem is a lament about the reality in which the wicked triumph.

"In the (.....) of his face the (.....) does not seek him; all his thoughts are, "There is no God."

Ch. 11) David sings that God is the only refuge in every desperate situation.

"The Lord tests the righteous, but his soul hates the (.....) and the one who (.....)."

"For the Lord is righteous; he loves (.....); the upright shall behold his face."

Ch. 12) "Because the poor are plundered, because the needy groan, I will now arise," says the Lord; "(.....)."

Ch. 13) What does David rely on in his fear, and what does he rejoice in?

Ch. 18) This is a song of a victory based on 2 Samuel 22.

For you save a humble people, but the haughty eyes you bring down."

Ch. 19) "Let the (.....) be acceptable in your sight, O Lord, my rock and my redeemer."

Ch. 20) The king, who is about to go to war, prays to God for victory.

Ch. 21) Paired with Psalm 20, this is a poem that gives all glory to God after winning the battle.

"Be exalted, O Lord, in your (.....)! We will sing and praise your (.....)."

SAT May 28

Ch. 22) David sings of his sufferings and triumphs. Ultimately, it is a poem that foretells the sufferings and triumphs of the Messiah. In verses 1-21, the psalmist grieves for God who does not answer his cry day and night, and for his situation. From verse 22, the psalmist praises God who has answered. Meditate on verse 24 and write it down.

Ch. 23) "The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters.... ...Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; (.....) they comfort me."

Ch. 24) This poem commemorates the ark of the covenant in Jerusalem after David ascended to the throne. Write down the words used 5 times in verses 7-10 to emphasize that God is strong and mighty.

Ch. 25) Because of the persecution of enemies, a man seeks God's help. Write down God's personality from the below verses.
