

**MON) JANUARY 9**

Ch. 25) Esau, returning from the field and exhausted, sells his birthright of the firstborn to eat the red stew from Jacob. What's the nickname for Esau that you got? (The nickname means red)

Ch. 26) Isaac, who was a livestock farmer, was blessed with God's 100 fold blessing in the land of Gerar. Since he has many sheep and cattle, and many servants, what are the Philistines envying and doing?

Ch. 27) Find out which of the following is NOT one of the blessing Isaac gave his son Jacob.

- 2) You will receive plenty of grain and wine.
