

**MON) JANUARY 16**

Ch. 49) In this chapter, Jacob calls his 12 sons and gives them a last will and blessing. Whom this blessing was for "The archers bitterly attacked him, shot at him, and harassed him severely, yet his bow remained unmoved;"

Ch. 50) After Jacob's funeral, a beautiful image of Joseph and the whole family united with love and forgiveness emerges. Joseph's brothers worry that after their father's death, Joseph might repay the evil they had done, but what did Joseph say to comfort them with?

Exodus Ch. 1) The children of Israel lived and multiplied in Egypt and became very strong, filling the whole land. Soon after, the new king of Egypt, threatened by this, orders the midwives to kill the Israeli baby boys. But who are the midwives who saved babies because they feared God and broke orders?

Ch. 2) In verse 1 of this chapter, it says "Now a man from the house of Levi went and took as his wife a Levite woman." What are names of father and mother of Moses in Exodus 6:14-27? (Hint 6:21)

**TUE) JANUARY 17**

Ch. 3) Moses, who received the commission of the exodus for the Israelites, rejected his incompetence by comparing it with the power of Pharaoh. Then, how does God ask Moses to introduce Himself to the Israelites? (This word means absolute sovereignty)

Ch. 4) Moses, who was commissioned on Mount Horeb, rejected the mission because he said he was not good at speaking despite God's three powerful signs. Who is the co-worker that the LORD have for Moses?

Ch. 5) What was the first thing Moses and Aaron asked of King Pharaoh?

- 1) Let the Israelites take a rest.
- 2) Send the Israelites to allow them to offer sacrifices to the LORD.
- 3) Supply more food to the Israelites.
- 4) Give the Israelites more straw for the bricks.

Ch. 6) This chapter reminds us once again of the covenant that God, who made a covenant to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, will take out the Israelites who are currently under the heavy burden of the Egyptians and lead them to the Promised Land. What does God hear to remember His covenant to the Israelites?

Ch. 7) When Moses and Aaron went to Pharaoh and spoke, how old were they each?

Ch. 8) Following the first plague in Chapter 7 (the water in the Nile turns into blood), this chapter records the second plague of frogs, the third plague of gnats, and the fourth plague of flies. Of these plagues, what are the two plagues that the Egyptian magicians also imitated?

Ch. 9) In the fifth plague recorded in this chapter—the death of livestock and the seventh plague—the hailstorm comes, there are verses showing God's special care for the children of Israel. Find each verse about how God took care of it.

Ch. 10) 1) When the eighth plague, the locust covered the ground, He heard Moses' prayer, and where did the LORD blow the western wind and drove the locust?

2) How many days does darkness remain in the land of Egypt by the ninth plague?

**THU) JANUARY 19**

Ch. 11) The tenth plague is the plague that strikes all the firstborn and says that there will be an unprecedented great cry throughout all the land of Egypt. "and every firstborn in the land of Egypt shall die, from the firstborn of (.....) who sits on his throne, even to the firstborn of the (.....) who is behind the handmill, and all the firstborn of the (.....).

Ch. 18) Jethro, Moses' father-in-law, recommended Moses to appoint commanders of a thousand, a hundred, fifty, and ten to take care of the Israelites. What was the qualification of these leaders?

**SAT) JANUARY 21**

Ch. 19) The third month after the Israelites left Egypt, they reached the Sinai wilderness. Here, God appears in dignity accompanied by supernatural phenomena. Write about the appearance of God's coming on the third morning, when the Israelites sanctified. (Verses 16-18)
