Ch. 12 - The Calling of Abram

Ch. 13 - Abram and his nephew Lot

Abram took his family down to Egypt because of the famine but returns to Bethel where he built the first altar to the Lord.

Afterwards, what did God told Abram to look, and promise to give what to whom by when? (vv. 14-15)

Ch. 14 - Abram Saves Lot

Here a war between Palestine's 4 Northern Kingdoms (Elam, Goyim, Shinar, Ellasar) verses Sodom's five kings (Sodom, Gomorrah, Admah, Zeboiim, and Zoar). The Northern Kingdoms win and take spoils including Lot.

Abram chased down Northern Kingdoms and rescues Lot and is victorious over them. During his return, he meets Melchizedek, king of Salem, who tells Abram that God Most High delivered your enemies into your hand! Abram, how much of everything did Abram give Melchizedek?

Ch. 15 - Covenant with Abram

Here recorded is God's Third Covenant to Abram (continued from chapters 12 and 13). Verse 6 states "And he believed the Lord, and he counted it to him as righteousness." Look up Habakkuk 2:4 and Romans 1:16-17, and write common words in these verses.
